Background

The **meetMED workshop on EE and RE Strategies and Policies** is organized by ADENE together with ADEME, ALMEE, RCREEE, as part of the activities of **meetMED** (Mitigation Enabling Energy Transition in the Mediterranean Region), an EU-funded project developed by MEDENER and RCREEE. It is hosted by NERC and will take place as a parallel event to the **6th MEDENER International Conference on Energy Transition in the Euro–Mediterranean Region**.

This workshop will serve as an opportunity for the **meetMED Regional Experts Network (REN)** to meet for the first time and present Country Policy Papers prepared by experts from Southern and Eastern Mediterranean Countries (SEMC) and best practices and/or case studies prepared by REN experts from non-SEMC.

During the workshop, the meetMED REN will also define the content of the meetMED report on EE and RE strategies and policies, which will focus on the Mediterranean countries targeted by the meetMED project: Algeria, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine and Tunisia.
